In 2013, we created a 'Building Greener Tree' - This year we wanted to make a forest! By encouraging teams accross Simons (and any visitors) to creare their own tree with their own commitments, we hope that we can increase the importance of sharing commitments, rasing awareness of resposnible sourcing and being environmetally sensitive across the activity."



Roll the Corporate Responsibility report summary into a tube, make sure the 'Last year in numbers' side is on the outside, with the green gridded background showing.



Secure your tube with a coffee cup holder at the bottom, and an inverted holder at the top, to keep the tube taught, secure with an elastic band in the middle.
